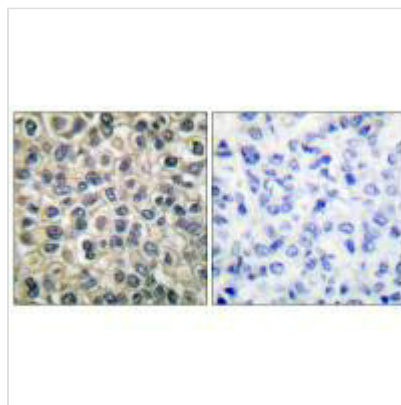




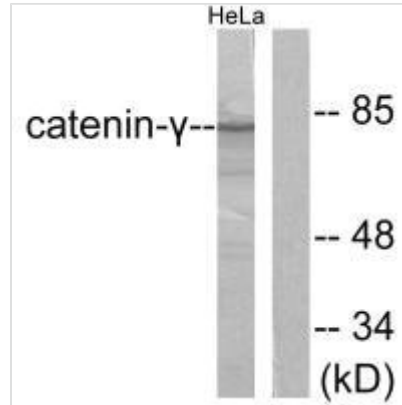
# JUP Antibody

<b>Storage</b>	Upon receipt, store at -20°C or -80°C. Avoid repeated freeze.

<b>Immunogen</b>	Synthesized peptide derived from Human Catenin- $\gamma$ .

<b>Specificity</b>	The antibody detects endogenous levels of total Catenin- $\gamma$ protein.

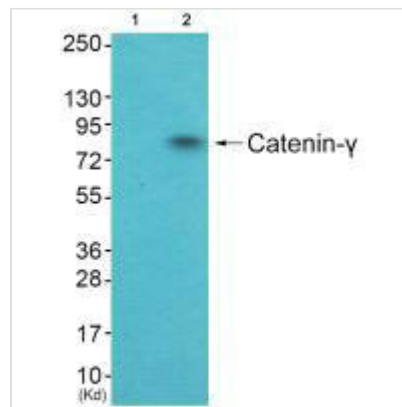
