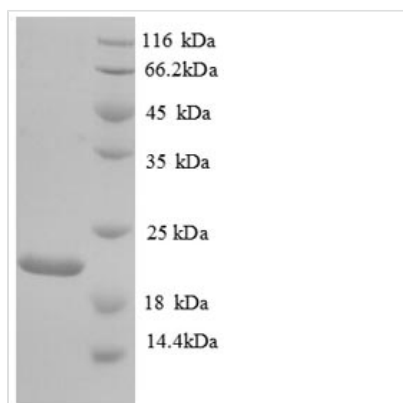




# Recombinant Human Urokinase-type plasminogen activator (PLAU), partial
