












Immunohistochemistry of paraffin-embedded human colon cancer using CSB-PA010418OA36nme1HU at dilution of 1:100

Immunofluorescent analysis of Hela cells using CSB-PA010418OA36nme1HU at dilution of 1:100 and Alexa Fluor 488-congugated AffiniPure Goat Anti-Rabbit IgG(H+L)



Chromatin Immunoprecipitation Hela (4*10⁶) were treated with Micrococcal Nuclease, sonicated, and immunoprecipitated with 8µg anti-HIST1H3A (CSB-PA010418OA36nme1HU) or a control normal rabbit IgG. The resulting ChIP DNA was quantified using real-time PCR with primers against the β -Globin promoter.
