

Western Blot




Goat polyclonal to rabbit IgG at 1/50000 dilution

Chromatin Immunoprecipitation Hela (4×10^6) were treated with Micrococcal Nuclease, sonicated, and immunoprecipitated with 5 μ g anti-HIST1H2BC (CSB-PA010403OA116nme1HU) or a control normal rabbit IgG. The resulting ChIP DNA was quantified using real-time PCR with primers against the β -Globin promoter.



Immunoprecipitating HIST1H2BC in MCF-7 whole cell lysate

Lane 1: Rabbit control IgG instead of CSB-PA010403OA116nme1HU in MCF-7 whole cell lysate. For western blotting, a HRP-conjugated Protein G antibody was used as the secondary antibody (1/2000)

Lane 2: CSB-PA010403OA116nme1HU (5 μ g) + MCF-7 whole cell lysate (500 μ g)

Lane 3: MCF-7 whole cell lysate (20 μ g)
