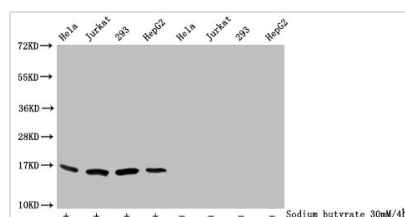

### Western Blot

Detected samples: Hela whole cell lysate, Jurkat whole cell lysate, 293 whole cell lysate, HepG2 whole cell lysate; Untreated (-) or treated (+) with 30mM sodium butyrate for 4h

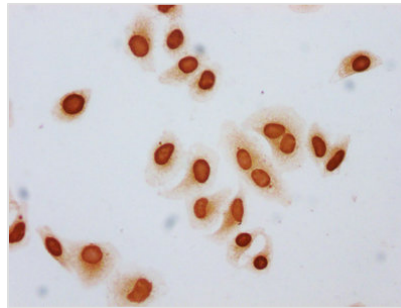
All lanes: HIST1H3A antibody at 1:1000

### Secondary

Goat polyclonal to rabbit IgG at 1/40000 dilution

Predicted band size: 16 kDa

Observed band size: 16 kDa



Immunocytochemistry analysis of CSB-PA010418OA79butHU diluted at 1:10 and staining in HeLa cells (treated with 30mM sodium butyrate for 4h) performed on a Leica Bond™ system. The cells were fixed in 4% formaldehyde, permeabilized using 0.2% Triton X-100 and blocked with 10% normal goat serum 30min at RT. Then primary antibody (1% BSA) was incubated at 4°C overnight. The primary is detected by a biotinylated secondary antibody and visualized using an HRP conjugated SP system.
