Notes	Repeated freezing and thawing is not recommended. Store working aliquots at 4°C for up to one week.

Target Details	This gene encodes a proline-rich protein. Studies of this gene and the related mouse gene suggest that this gene is regulated by p53 and may participate in p53-mediated growth suppression. The encoded protein may function as a microtubule destabilizing protein that controls spindle dynamics and mitotic progression by recruiting and regulating microtubule depolymerases. At least one genetic variation in this gene has been associated with decreased serum levels of low-density lipoprotein cholesterol. Alternatively spliced transcript variants encoding different isoforms have been described.
Reconstitution	We recommend that this vial be briefly centrifuged prior to opening to bring the contents to the bottom. Please reconstitute protein in deionized sterile water to a concentration of 0.1-1.0 mg/mL. We recommend to add 5-50% of glycerol (final



concentration) and aliquot for long-term storage at -20°C/-80°C. Our default final concentration of glycerol is 50%. Customers could use it as reference.
