Target Details	A segmental duplication of the p arm of chromosome 16 created two identical copies of the GIY-YIG domain containing gene, this record represents the more telomeric copy. Exons of this gene overlap with exons of the phenol-preferring sulfotransferase (SULT1A4) gene. Two transcript variants that encode different protein isoforms have been identified through sequence analysis.
Reconstitution	We recommend that this vial be briefly centrifuged prior to opening to bring the contents to the bottom. Please reconstitute protein in deionized sterile water to a concentration of 0.1-1.0 mg/mL. We recommend to add 5-50% of glycerol (final concentration) and aliquot for long-term storage at -20°C/-80°C. Our default final concentration of glycerol is 50%. Customers could use it as reference.
